RULES and REGULATIONS

- 1. All exhibitors are subject to the general rules and livestock rules, in addition to the particular rules listed here.
- 2. NO Myotonic Goat Bucks may arrive before Thursday of Fair week.
- 3. NO Myotonic bucks or any other Goat bucks be housed in Old MacDonald's Barn.

- 4. The Myotonic Goat Registry (MGR) sanction show rules shall govern and take precedence over all others.
- 5. At check-in, all exhibitors will need to present MGR registration with matching identification (tattoo, scrapie tag or microchip).
- 6. Exhibitors must provide own feed and hay. Note: Storage is limited so no more than one tack area per person. All aisles must remain accessible for Fair patrons.
- 7. Pen fees of \$10 cash per pen in in effect. All pen fees will be held during the Fair. After the show on Saturday, exhibitors shall have the option of cleaning pens to have the fee returned. Any pen fees not returned shall be given to an individual interested in cleaning the remainer of the pens. No animals will be checked-in until the exhibitors pays their pen fee(s).

DIVISION 1: YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP

All Youth Showmanship exhibitors must know their breeder number and have the participating goats MGR registration certificate with registration number available. The youth classes are not for Sanction points with your goat but to earn expectation points towards the youth program. Showmanship classes open only to MGR Youth Breeders.
