# **RULES and REGULATIONS**

- 1. All exhibitors are subject to the general rules and regulations and the livestock rules in addition to the particular rules listed here.
- 2. One entry per breeder in all group classes.
- 3. Individual class entries are limited to two (2) premiums per class.
- 4. No added entries allowed on show day.
- 5. Check in will be Sunday, 1pm 5pm. Registration papers will be checked at that time. Individual papers <u>must</u> be supplied for each animal.

- 6. Water is the only substance that may be placed in the skin of the animals to enhance show ring appearance. Residue of other products must be complexly removed prior to entering the showring.
- 7. Please be considerate of fellow exhibitors by keeping the wash rack area clean. It is understood the wash racks are in use throughout the shows, however if you have used the wash racks prior or during the show, please clean up the area at the completion of the show.


